Subject: **3 Patrons have tested positive for COVID-19**

We are writing to inform you that 3 individuals who attended the Perth Legion have tested positive for COVID-19. The Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit is closely monitoring the situation and is in contact with, and has isolated all who have had a high risk exposure.

Program participants and staff receiving this notice **did not** have a high risk exposure and can continue to participate in the program. Please continue to complete the [COVID 19 Screening Tool](#) prior to participating in community activities (e.g. sports, recreation programs, clubs etc.).

We are encouraging everyone to continue with [public health recommendations](#) to reduce the spread of COVID-19.

- Monitor for [symptoms](#) carefully. **Testing for COVID-19 is not recommended** unless symptoms develop.
- If symptoms develop:
 - Immediately [self-isolate](#).
 - Contact the Health Unit at 1-800-660-5853.
 - Get tested at a [local assessment centre](#).
